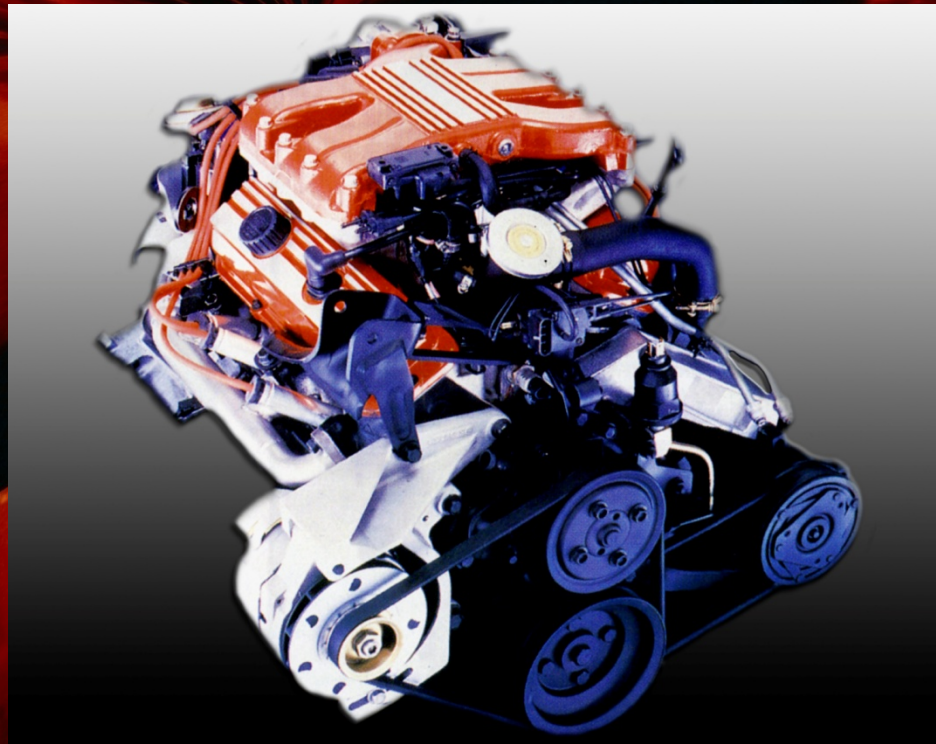
Exploring the 1985 Fiero

- The 1985 Fiero colors included: Light Gray Metallic, White, Black and Red
- This was the first year for the rear deck lid “hump” and the engine vents were moved to the sides of the rear deck lid
- This was the first year that Pontiac added coat hooks
- Stereo backlit lighting changed from green to red except for the clock display.

The 1985 Fiero was the year that they offered the high output V6 2.8L engine

1985 Pontiac Fiero by the numbers

- **Total number produced – 76,371 down from 136,840 in 1984**
- **% of total production of 370,168 – 20.63%**
- **MSRP range from the Coupe to the Indy Pace car - \$8,495-11,795**
- **On a side note for the 1985 production year the 1985 GT (\$11,795) was less then the 1984 Indy Pace car (\$12,482)**

The 1985 production year was the first and only year that Pontiac offered the Fiero GT with a notchback (besides the 1984 Indy Pace Car)
